On Thursday, May 21, 2015 Mr. Michael J. Helgesen, Certified Financial Planner (CFP) and Financial Advisor, was the guest speaker at the General Alumnae meeting. Mr. Helgesen, the creator of "Dynamic Mapping," a process that helps individuals and small businesses visualize and understand their key opportunities and risks, presented an interesting and entertaining discussion on financial management. In very understandable language, Mike showed us how over time we can save time and money as we grapple with the unexpected expenses of life, assuring that we do not run out of money.

Mike made the following important points:

- Try to enter retirement mortgage free and pay extra principle on the front end of your mortgage if possible.
- Set up a 529 account for your grandchildren if you can, as it is increasingly more challenging for our children to save enough money for their children's education.
- 3. When choosing a financial planner keep these points in mind:
- Choose someone who's own house in in order, i.e. stable financially and personally
- Choose someone who has an established career
- Do not choose someone on the back end of his career, as they are more likely to pass off their clients to someone just staring out

It was an enjoyable evening and I think we all came away with a few pearls of wisdom that were helpful.




The site of the former School of Nursing is now called 150 West 12th Street, a restored property that is describes
